

ABOUT Us and Our Mission

The Ripple Effect Wellness Organization (TREWO) is a registered Canadian charity dedicated to educating and empowering Canadians to lead healthy lives through proactive decision making.

Founded by Order of Canada recipient Dr. Sudi Devanesen and Ravi S. Juneja (one of the original founders and past presidents of the East Indian Professional Residents of Canada - EIPROC), TREWO bridges the care gap between physicians and patients by educating patients and those seeking medical advice or opinion.

As we celebrate Canada's cultural diversity, we also need to care about the communities that contribute toward this rich diversity, who are at risk for various social, mental and health issues. TREWO provides information on health and wellness in general, based on the best science available today. We do not receive any financial support from the federal or provincial governments. Our core funding comes from individual donations and from donations received through our corporate partnerships. Our mission is to create healthy communities by education and addressing health issues. Knowledge is the best preventative medication one can have.

SOME KEY TREWO PROJECTS Fundraising Activities

Each year TREWO has organized fundraising events such as 15 very successful Galas and several Golf tournaments.

Trillium Health Partners Foundation (THPF)

A donation of \$50,000 was made to the THP Foundation to help construct an assessment and resuscitation room within the ER of Credit Valley Hospital which was opened in the Summer of 2018. TREWO donated \$10,000 to Trillium Health Partners for personal protective equipment during the Covid pandemic.

Heather Hamlin Seniors Home, Roofs for the Roofless

TREWO has also extended its reach internationally by donating over \$50,000 for medical and health services to the disadvantaged and poverty stricken seniors in Chennai, India. It has played a key role in the Anjar Project and Roofs for the Roofless in India. \$15,000 was donated for Senior Health Care under Roofs for the Roofless to rebuild the Centre devastated by severe flooding.

Community & Youth Mental Health Programs

In 2014 TREWO sponsored "How Everyday Kindness is Changing the World" a presentation by award-winning, writer and film-maker Pavi Mehta. Also in 2014, TREWO published it's first book, Welcome to Wellness, a guide to healthy living, inside and out.

Our youth group launched two educational campaigns on COVID in English and Punjabi. The youth group is launching a series of health and wellness clips on social media this year on various topics of great importance for all ages.

Webinar Outreach Wing (WOW)

The Ripple Effect Wellness Organization, through its Webinar Outreach Wing has sponsored several Webinars/Symposiums over the last five years. They have featured inspiring and thought provoking presentations that have been timely and informative. Topics have included Covid 19, Cyber Security, Financial Literacy, Pandemic Challenges, Dementia & Heart Disease. This year WOW has had two successful webinars on Heart attacks and Addictions and two more planned for September and November 2024. These webinars now have a global audience with an increasing number of registrants and very positive feedback as they successfully integrate the objectives of TREWO.

Our Goals For 2024 & Beyond

Our goal is to bridge the gap between doctors and patients and provide information and advice via a number of languages and platforms. Given the enormity of the Canadian health landscape. TREWO will continue working with youth, to promote health and wellness, and will be supporting Health and Wellness Education campaigns at multiple Secondary Schools, Colleges, Universities and through seminars.

TREWO will make a special effort to identify health risks particularly in youth, women and seniors where cultural sensitivity is required in difficult situations like accessing appropriate care, domestic violence, elder abuse and mental health.
